GOD'S MISSION DESPITE THE WAR



We hear most of the time about the war in Iraq. However there is also better news that comes to us from that disturbed and wounded country.



According to the current reports of Baptist leaders who know the local situation, the Iraqi people are now much more open to the Gospel than ever before. In spite of the war there have been thousands of Bibles



distributed, numerous evangelistic events were organized and new churches have been started. There are for example around 3000 Evangelical believers in 12 churches in Baghdad alone. Some new Baptist congregations were also started in the north of Iraq.

Pray for the advancing ministry of the Gospel & church planting in Iraq. Pray that the presently observed spiritual openness of the Iraqi people will continue and potential obstacles will be overcome. Pray that the reconciliation between all of the people of this wounded country will happen as soon as possible.
